

The Inaugural Smokin' Brew BBQ Cow Pie Bingo Fundraiser
Official Rules and Regulations
September 6th, 2015

1. The Rotary BBQ Committee will establish all rules and regulations for the Cow Pie Bingo Fundraiser.
2. Cow Pie Bingo will take place at the grass/dirt lot to the West of the Parker Station Parking lot. The Smokin' Brew BBQ will be taking place in the Parker Station Parking lot during the weekend. Any ticket booth at the BBQ will have details and directions to the Cow Pie Bingo Fundraiser.
3. A donation of \$10.00 to CCV Rotary Club of Parker is encouraged for each square received. One ticket is equal to one square.
4. No purchase is necessary in order to obtain a square. However, participants are highly encouraged to make a \$10.00 donation to the CCV Rotary Club of Parker. All proceeds of the fundraiser are used by the CCV Rotary Club of Parker to give back to the community and throughout the world. Please see attached sheet for list of projects that the CCV Rotary Club of Parker supports. One free ticket per person may be obtained by filling out a written request on a 3"X5" card with name, address, and phone number, then mail to 19751 E Mainstreet Suite 380, Parker, CO 80138. Request must be received by September 5th, 2015 to qualify. The CCV Rotary Club of Parker cannot be held responsible for lost requests due to the USPS or any delivery source.
5. Participants must be 18 or older to participate.
6. Participant need not be present to win.
7. Participant is responsible for all associated fees/taxes associated with winning.
8. No tickets will be issued after September 5th 2015 at 8pm.
9. For each ticket sold, the "stub" will be placed in a sealed, non-transparent envelope by event organizers. Once the grid is determined, the stubs will be randomly drawn and placed in order on an open square on the grid.
10. The grid will be placed on the fence of the Cow Pie Bingo event prior to the event starting. The grid will have the ticket #s placed on the squares that are owned by that ticket number. No names will be placed on the grid.
11. The actual grid on the ground will be clearly marked with all squares being of equal shape and size. The area will be protected by a barrier or fence. Spectators and ticket holders must not interfere with the progress of the event.
12. There will be three independent judges working the event. The judges will not be able to participate in the event as to keep them totally impartial to any outcomes.
13. At 2:00 pm on September 6th, 2015, a cow will be led into the grid area by an appropriate handler and let free to roam within the area until a cow pie is placed on a square. If the first cow has not placed a cow pie within 30 minutes, a second cow will be brought out and replace the first. If the second cow has not placed a cow pie within 30 minutes it will be removed as well. The group of independent judges will draw from all names in the event and a winner will be selected.

14. The square containing the biggest volume of cow pie will win half of the amount of tickets sold, up to \$10,000.
15. If the cow pie lands on 2 or more squares and it is determined that the volume is equal, the owners of the squares would share the prize money in equal percentages.
16. If the cow pie lands on a square that is unsold, the winner will be the closest "sold" square in proximity to the cow pie. This could end up being more than one winner, which would share in the prize money equally.
17. Any disputes or claims must be registered with the judges.
18. The winner will be recognized on stage during the awards Smokin' Brew BBQ Awards Ceremony. A check will be mailed to the winner within 2 weeks after the conclusion of the event. Winner must complete a W-9 IRS form before a check will be mailed.
19. The rules and regulations will be posted at the event and can be obtained by the Smokin' Brew BBQ Committee upon request.
